Subject: Request for Certificate of Insurance for BARE RENTALS of Equipment

Please provide a certificate of Insurance to McClain & Company, Inc. that shows your company's General Liability, Automobile Liability and Workers Comp coverage's. Under the Auto section the hired auto and non-owned auto boxes both must be checked.

Most Auto policies only cover the chassis of the rental unit so it's important to specifically check with your provider to see what yours covers. There must be coverage in place for the equipment mounted to the chassis, as well as, the chassis itself. If your coverage is only for the chassis then we will also need a Contractor's Equipment Floater or Inland Marine Ryder added so that the booms mounted to the chassis are also covered. The Floater/Ryder amount should be in the amount of the replacement value of the rental unit. The equipment floater amount as well as the deductible both need to be shown on the COI. See Sample Certificate.

For one time rentals VIN# or Serial# is recommended to be mentioned in the descriptions box. For annual projects our equipment list may be attached and you may rent any combination of items within your specified equipment floater limit. McClain & Co., Inc. must be named in the descriptions box as additionally insured and Loss payee.

The COI must provide for \$1,000,000.00 liability coverage for Bodily Injury (per person) and for Property Damage respectively, as well as including All Risk Coverage. Note that All Risk Coverage is an antiquated term. It specifically meant all items were covered unless specifically excluded. If your company is covered for "theft" that is sufficient.

Subs will need to be named as additional insured as well; otherwise, each Sub needing to use the equipment will also need to provide an their own Insurance Certificate as described above.

Please ask your Regional Manager for replacement costs for the machine being rented. If renting multiples, the floater should be for the combined amount of each replacement value.

Per USDOT regulations any drivers of commercial vehicles weighing 10,001 lb or greater are required to carry a valid medical examination card. Vehicles over 26,000lb require CDL. USDOT regulations in force.
